The awareness of environmental topics has always been inherent in the mode of operation of Medac. Recycling experience of cardboard / oils / ferrous materials / packaging etc. are part of the daily productive life for years.

The General Management has adopted an environmental management system with reference to the international standard UNI EN ISO 14001 and is therefore committed to:

- identify the interested parties by determining the needs and expectations that have become internal compliance obligations;
- comply with all applicable legal requirements and other commitments signed by Medac in relation to the environment;
- continuous improvement and pollution prevention, through the control of the energy used, the containment of emissions into the atmosphere, and the identification of the life cycle of its products, in order to avoid the involuntary displacement of its environmental impacts;
- the designation, control and implementation of the environmental management system;
- the continuous updating of the staff on the best practices that can be adopted in relation to the expected outcomes;
- the definition of objective and quantified environmental objectives and targets.

These results can only be achieved with the creation of a system of measurement of parameters having influence on the environment that allows, clear and timely manner to identify and quantify the risks (potential or actual) and implement improvement actions.
