

General Management has adopted a management system in accordance with FSC-STD-40-004 (FSC Standard for Chain of Custody Certification) and is committed to:

- implement the social responsibility management system in accordance with the requirements defined in standard FSC-STD-40-004
- verify the FSC® certification of purchased paper and of the relevant suppliers
- not use wood-based materials originating from “controversial sources”
- train personnel involved in the Chain of Custody system
- use the FSC® logo only in association with products that meet the minimum characteristics required by the relevant reference standards
- suspend the sale of products as FSC® certified if the product does not comply with the requirements of the standard defined in the relevant Quality Plan
- a commitment to refrain from any direct or indirect involvement in activities that entail:
 - illegal logging or trading in illegal wood or forest products;
 - the violation of human and traditional rights in forestry operations;
 - the destruction of “High Conservation Values” in forestry operations (*);
 - the significant conversion of forests into plantations or non-forest land use destinations;
 - the introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
 - the violation of any ILO Fundamental Convention, as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (1998).
