PEFC® Policy (PEFC™ ST 2002)

General Management has adopted a management system in accordance with PEFC ITA 2002 – Chain of Custody Certification Scheme for forest-based products, and is committed to:

- implement the social responsibility management system in accordance with the requirements defined in the ITA 1002 standard
- verify the PEFC™ certification of purchased paper and its related suppliers
- not use wood materials originating from “controversial sources”
- train all personnel involved in the Chain of Custody system
- use the PEFC™ logo only in association with products that meet the minimum requirements set by the relevant standards
- suspend the sale of products as PEFC™-certified if they do not comply with the standard requirements defined in the relevant Quality Plans
- a commitment not to be directly or indirectly involved in activities that involve:
 - illegal logging or trading in illegal wood or forest products;
 - the violation of human and traditional rights in forestry operations;
 - the destruction of “High Conservation Values” in forestry operations;
 - the significant conversion of forests into plantations or non-forest land use destinations;
 - the introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
 - the violation of any ILO Fundamental Convention, as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (1998).
